

California's Safe Drinking Water & Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 Declaration

Dear Valued Customers,

This letter is to inform Pouch Worth customers that we have received written declarations from our 1st tier suppliers that items sold by Pouch Worth are made from raw materials that do not contain chemicals which are listed on California's Safe Drinking Water & Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986.

This Act, commonly known as Proposition 65 (Prop 65), establishes a list of chemicals which the state of California's risk assessment process has determined to present a risk of cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. The chemical list can be found at:

We will continue to monitor the Proposition 65 regulations for any new chemicals. Pouch Worth staff will compare newly listed chemicals with the raw materials, partially converted, and fully converted goods in our finished product and communicate this information to our customers.

Pouch Worth shall not be liable to purchaser for failure to comply with this declaration unless, within ten (10) business days after you believe such failure to comply has occurred or you receive any communication alleging noncompliance of Pouch Worth products with laws cited above, you furnish Pouch Worth the basis for your belief or a copy of such communication, and it is proven that Pouch Worth product(w) are the direct and proximate cause of the non-compliance event.
