To our valued customer:

The RoHS directives apply to electronic components. Per the regulations we have read, RoHS does not apply to packaging materials. However, we do send out courtesy letters advising of the status of our Materials compared to the regulations.

Basically, CONEG is more stringent on levels of lead, mercury, cadmium, and hexavalent chromium than RoHS is. Therefore, since we have CONEG letters from each of our raw material Suppliers, and we do not add any of the four regulated items in our process or handling, we can ascertain that our materials are in fact compliant on these issues.

The other two listed items in the directives are not tested for, but they are not reasonably expected to be present. They are not present during the manufacture of the raw materials and they are not present during our processing.
